RSWB, GR, TG, GS, 25/8/63, III, 161. Good malachite,
bornite, tetrahedrite, galena, blende,
pyrite, chalcoppyrite, hydrozincite (blue
fluorescent), calcite, quartz, - at
Ardtully Copper mine near Ardtully House.
Canadians had recently been drilling - cores
stacked at site (Barren).

In nearby quarry ca 100 yds N of road, entrance

ca 100 yds E of lane to mine. Grey limestone, with
thin calcite veins; specks of azurite malachite,
assoc. with massive hexahedrite.

Radtully Lead mine has flooded square
shaft, small low dumps of grey limestone,
with calcite veinlets. A little galena;
baryte; quartz.

chrysocolla, clinoclase farn of ~1 mm
blades/plates (w. azurite cornw); cornwallite,
malach, tyrolite sheaves to ~5 mm;
zalesite (1 small spec. 0.5 mm needles).

lavendulan, linarite, mimetite, monohydro-
-calcite, olivinite (minute, blocky xls.), parasymplectite,
phannouxit - rauenthalite (exchange studied),
posnjakite, smolyaninovite. "Limonite".
Pale ~~blue~~ blue powdery coatings mostly amorphous,
one poss. tyrolite (?).

ROSS ISLAND MINE, Killarney, Kerry, Ireland.

AR, MM 21 386 On S shore of Ross Island.

Copper ores - chalcopysite; bornite & tetrahedrite;
with calcite. Rarely: native copper;
cuprite (including xls); malachite; azurite.

At E end of workings is large water-logged
opencast - "Blue Hole" - ores chalcopysite in N part
& in S part fine grained mixt of blende, galena,
pyrite, & chalcopysite (cf "Blue stone" of Anglesey).
Smithsonite also - brownish, cellular.

Serpierite - v. small green-blue spherical
aggregates in the smithsonite.

"Blue Hole" (actually muddy brown!); beach in front of
it, and main workings, further W [these latter
largely barren].

Malachite; azurite specks & coatings; galena;
chalcophyrite; blende; hemimorphite; brown
cellular smithsonite; "blue-stone ore". In
cavities in the smithsonite, blue to green
microcrystalline things, & ? anglesite.
? aurichalcate or serpierite; ? linarite.
