Late news: New Irish Zinc Mine

Specialist engineering group Davy International has landed a contract to build a zinc and lead mine in Ireland as part of the Trafalgar House consortium. Davy, along with Cementation will design and build the mine and processing plant at the site in Galmoy, County Kilkenny. The contract, said to be worth tens of millions of pounds, will start shortly and the mine is expected to be in operation by mid-1996. Arcon

International, the Irish-based developer of the mine has signed a letter of intent on the deal with Davy, but final negotiations on price continue.

When it is up and running Galmoy will employ around 200 people and will be one of Europe's largest producers of zinc and lead concentrates.
