"geological
Memoires" (author not remembered) report
tourmaline about the fault lines between
the metamorphic/carboniferous rocks N/East
of Collooney, Co. Sligo (Not to be confused
with similar-sounding Coolaney) - This
would be on the ~~the~~ N and E flanks
of Dacane Mt. @ Lough Gill (This area is
not truly Ox Mtns, being more an Easterly assoc'd
mountain range, & it is just possible that the old
report is elsewhere but the old report does say
"Near Collooney". My only experience of this area

was $\frac{1}{2}$ hr @ a large roadside q'y of a cement firm
- I think "Maze/Concrete". This q'y would cut away back
into the fault lines. Q'y mostly carboniferous, lots of
corallines & vein masses of a black brittle v. hard
semi-xline rock (cuts glass) - chert? also lots of
corallines in the black carboniferous lined with Pearl
Spar, often iridescent, & coatings of quartz xls, some
clear some lemon-colour, iridescent with rainbow
bands of colour, pinks greens etc. v. pretty (?? the
"tourmaline" ??). There is also magnetic
(? Ni-iferous) serpentine in the area - in the
valley between ~~the~~ Daeane/Slishwood Mtns.
