(MONTE) CAMPIONE, Tessin, Switzerland

Miers (1929) Superb kyanite, with staurolite in
a white paragonite (mica) schist, at Monte
Campioni.

CAMPOLONGO, Tessin, Switzerland.

Miers (1929) Corundum, opaque red or blue xls generally imperfect, but sometimes in terminated prisms, in the white dolomite, assoc with silvery mica, diaspore, & green tourmaline (Diaspore = $\text{AlO}(\text{OH})$, white, scaly, brittle, talcose, often coating corundum)

Tremolite, long white or greyish, ~~to~~ translucent blade-like prisms with vert. striations, in the granular white or grey dolomite

Kyanite with stannolite in a white paragonite (mica) schist at Monte Campione.

Phlogopite, pale yellow lustrous scales & hexag. plates
in the granular white dolomite.

The white granular dolomite ~~specks~~ also yields
green prisms of tourmaline assoc with corundum,
calcite, mica, & diaspore.

MA 2 563. E. Artini. A small darkish-green tabular hexag
xl cg 4mm across on dolomite matrix with corund, etc
proved to be chrysokeryl.

monohydrocalcite

MA 2 220 H. Preiswerk. Scapolite, prisms & bundles of rods (10 cm) of fresh glassy material found in crevices in the schists at several spots near Prato in Val Leventina, Ticino.
