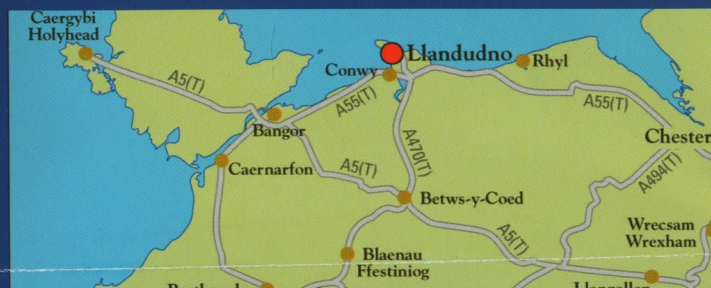


Tram. Every 20 minutes from Llandudno

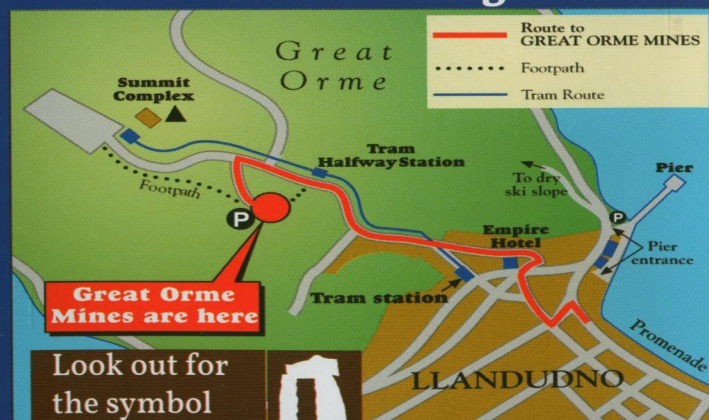

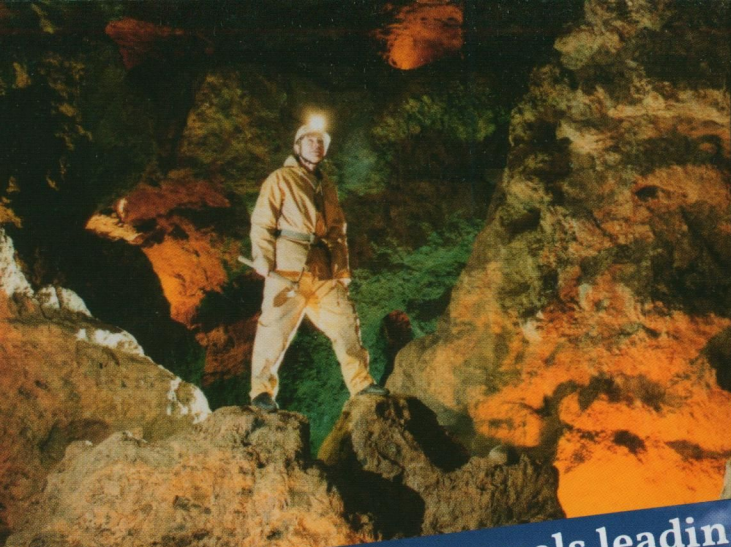
